Guidelines for in-person visits

- 1. In person visits will take place outdoors, weather permitting. Indoor visits will take place in the recreation lounge.
- 2. All visitors must be screened for any signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
- 3. Any visitor identified to have any of these signs or symptoms or a fever will be denied access to the facility
- 4. Visitors who had close contact with someone with COVID-19 infection in the prior 14 days (regardless of the visitor's vaccination status) will be denied entry to the facility and in-person visit until after 14 days
- 5. Once screening is complete, the facility will provide visitors with proper PPE (masks and gloves) to be worn for the duration of the visit. Face shields, although not required, will be offered
- 6. Visitors and resident (if medically able) must wear face mask, covering mouth and nose, for the duration of the visit.
- 7. PPE should be donned by visitors at the completion of the screening process
- 8. Visitors should perform hand hygiene after screening process, before and after visitation period (Hand sanitizer is acceptable)
- 9. Visitors who refuse to wear PPE or adhere to social distancing rules will be denied access to facility or be asked to leave during visit
- 10. Visitors should not make physical contact with resident. Social distancing at least six feet between persons should be maintained
- 11. All in-person visits will be supervised by staff at all times during visits to ensure the maintaining of proper distancing, infection control and safety of the resident
- 12. Residents who are new admissions (or re-admissions) to the facility need to stay in quarantine x 14 days and can only receive visits that are virtual or through windows
- 13. Max number of visitors per resident at a time should not exceed 2 per resident
